## Horseshoe Project Official Groundbreaking Saturday, April 27

**April 22, 2013** – On Saturday, April 27, Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) and Pegasus Link Constructors (PLC) will hold a groundbreaking event to officially mark the start of the TxDOT Horseshoe project, a 4-year, \$798 million construction project that will ease traffic congestion, improve safety and enhance mobility between Interstates 30 and 35E through downtown Dallas, the Mixmaster and the city's central business district.

Media are invited to attend the ceremony to hear elected officials and TxDOT representatives provide remarks about the project, its impact to the community and its role within the revitalization of Dallas.

### About the Horseshoe Project

The Horseshoe Project is a \$798 million design-build highway construction project by the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) to improve traffic flow through the heart of downtown Dallas. Dubbed "Horseshoe" because of its U shape, the 4-year construction project begins in spring 2013 and will include the expansion, repaving and addition of several new bridges and roadways along Interstates 30 and 35E across the Trinity River, and through the city's Mixmaster and central business district.

With construction management by Pegasus Link Constructors (PLC), the Horseshoe Project is expected to finish in 2017, and once completed, motorists will experience improved safety, ease in traffic congestion and increased mobility when traveling through downtown Dallas.
